Title of Source:

Citation Information

Citation Page:

**County Name, State, Book or Record, page number**

Examples:

Texas Co, MO Deed Book J pg 263

Texas Co, MO Marriage Book 3 pg 153

Texas Co, MO Will Book 1 pg 158

Texas Co, MO Probate Minute Book 1 pg 522

Texas Co, MO 1867 Personal Property Tax Book Township 6 Section 23 (some have page numbers, some are by district and then grouped by alpha of the last name)

Citation Text:

**Any pertinent notes regarding the record.**

**You can have them print or not.**

**You can make a note that you have the document or a copy of it and select not print. If you then want to find out what records you have actual documents for you can create a special report to search for the words have doc(uments) in sources for any fact field.**

You may use much of the citation information in the fact field (like for the census years) I don't feel it is necessary to source that fact if you have all the information in the field already. If you only put location, but not the rest of the information, page, house, etc, then you would want to source the information.
