## Scanning and Photo Editing



### Scanning Tips

- Be consistent in the way you scan
- Determine what size works best for you (8x10)
- Determine how many dots per inch you want to scan in (300-600)
- Determine the format (.tif, .jpg loses pixels when you resave the image)
- Familiarize yourself with your scanning software
- Familiarize yourself with your photo editor



### Scanning Software

- Set the scanning format
- Set the dots per inch
- Set the size
- Do preview
-  crop to image desired
-  use the auto adjust
- If need to edit color dark, light, contrast, do so in the scan by adjusting the advanced controls



- You can reverse polarization 
- You can reverse image 

### Photo Editing Software

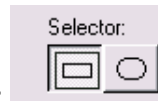
-  Cloning tool

Red Eye removal use after



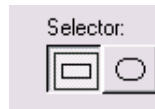
selecting the oval



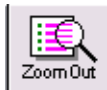
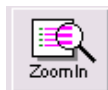
Image orientation manipulation
